Organ Recital

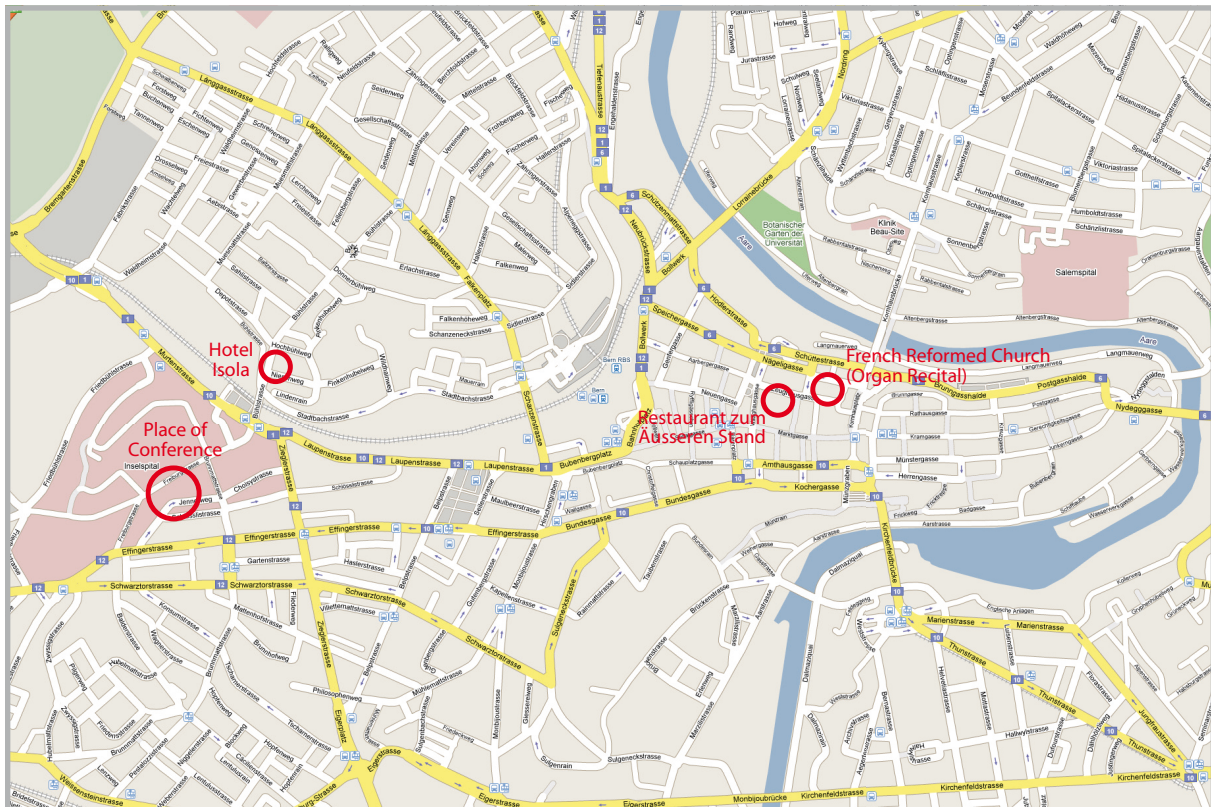

Works will be offered from four centuries of Organ music, including composers from Francisco Correa de Arauxo to Olivier Messiaen and John Cage.

Social Evening

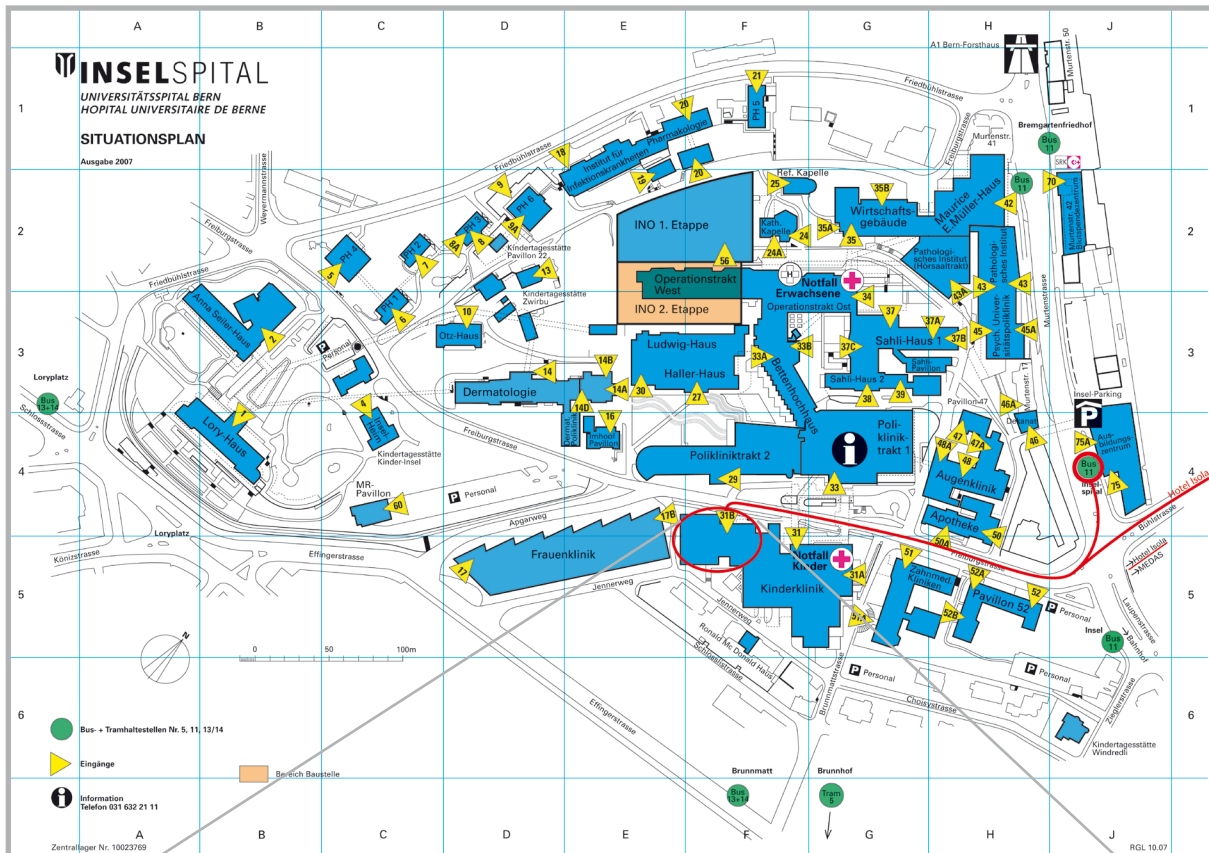
