Doctoral Project aim

Clarification of the experience of ‘grace’ from the perspective of lay-persons in a secularized society

- bottom-up lay-definition of grace
- insight in the lived experience of grace
- scale-construction (experience of grace, openness for grace)
- relation grace and other virtues (e.g. humility, forgiveness)




Study Lay Definition of Grace

- 450 lay descriptions of grace (online questionnaire)
- qualitative-quantitative content analyses

Results

Figure 1 - Visualization of the emerging characteristics of a lay conceptualization of grace based on the reported quantitative and qualitative content analysis



Highlights Lay- Definition

- robustness underlying characteristics (see Figure 1)
- significant group differences:
 - believing or older participants describe more extra-ordinary and transcendent elements
 - nonbelievers more about faults and forgiveness
 - believing people report more positive feelings in their definition
 - women more virtuous characteristics




Study Experience of Grace

- 456 person-level narratives about experiences with grace
- qualitative thematic network analysis

Results

Figure 2- Visualisation of network of emerging themes based on the qualitative thematic analysis



Highlights Experiences of Grace

- can happen anywhere anytime
- often precede by difficulties Experience
- unmerited free gift
- goodness and beauty
- divine and human source
- transformation intrapersonal, interpersonal, situational level
