We invite you to participate in the 2-day Pre-Conference Research Workshop with Prof. Koenig and European Experts. **The workshop is open to all interested in doing research on religion, spirituality and health** (accepting participants of any educational level or degree, including theologians, chaplains, physicians, nurses, psychologists, pastoral counselors, public health specialists, epidemiologists, or other).

Prof. Koenig of Duke University Medical Center is known as senior author of the "Handbook of Religion and Health". Furthermore **Prof. Koenig is director of the Center for Spirituality, Theology and Health** at Duke University and distinguished Adjunct Professor at King Abdulaziz University in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia. The center at Duke University used to offer a 1-year post-doctoral fellowship in religion and health, which Prof. Koenig has compressed into 4-day workshops. **The European experts that contribute to the workshop** are: Prof. Deborah Lycet, Prof. Jessie Dezutter, Prof. Arndt Büsing, Prof. Niels Hvidt and Dr. René Hefti.
